🐾 Lifestyle & Schedule Reasons

- 1. Busy work schedule (long hours, shift work, or working from home but unable to take breaks).
- 2. Business travel or out-of-town commitments.
- 3. Social commitments (regular outings, events, or appointments).
- 4. **New baby in the household** needing help juggling responsibilities.

- 20. **Owner injury or illness** temporarily unable to walk the dog.
- 21. Disability or chronic condition affecting mobility.



- 22. **Senior owners** who may not be able to keep up with their dog's needs.

- 24. **Apartment or condo living** no private yard access.
- 25. Shared household where not everyone agrees to care for the dog.
- 26. **HOA or building regulations** limiting off-leash access.
